Assumption of Risk, Release of Liability Waiver

By signing this form, I, or my legal guardian if I am under the age of 18, confirm that I have voluntarily requested **Firearm (Safety) Instruction and/or Training** (referred to herein as the "Activity") from **Northwest School of Safety** held on (date) _____.

As a condition of that request, I waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue, and agree to hold **Northwest School of Safety**, its owner(s), officers, servants, agents, volunteers and employees (hereafter referred to as the "Releasees") from and against any and all liabilities, demands, claims, or injuries, including death, that I may sustain during or in conjunction with the Activity.

_____ I **acknowledge and agree that my safety is primarily my own responsibility**. I assume all risks and I agree to make sure that I fully understand how to safely participate in the Activity, and I agree to observe all rules and practices that may be employed to minimize the risk of injury. I agree to stop and seek assistance if I do not believe I can safely continue, to limit my participation to reflect my personal fitness level, and to refrain from any and all actions that would pose a hazard to myself or others.

_____ I affirm that I am a citizen of good repute, have never been convicted of any crime of violence, and I am legally able to purchase, possess or handle a firearm according to Federal Firearm requirements.

_____ I understand that occasionally, in order to protect myself, other students, or property, or for firearm demonstration and/or instruction purposes, it may be appropriate and necessary for the instructor/range (safety) officer/assistant to touch me or my firearm, and I give consent to this action.

I confirm that I have read this document in its entirety and fully understand the terms and conditions, as well as the Four Rules of Firearm Safety and I commit to following them at all times during the Activity.

The Four Rules of Firearm Safety

- 1) Treat all guns as if they were always loaded.
- 2) Never point the firearm at anything you are not willing to destroy.
- 3) Keep your finger off the trigger until you are on target and ready to shoot.
- 4) Be sure of your target and what lies beyond.
